


Infringement cases against Slovenia open on 31 December (2015-2019)



New infringement cases opened in 2019: main policy areas




Late transposition infringement cases against Slovenia open on 31 December (2015-2019)

IMPORTANT JUDGMENTS

Court ruling1

There were no major Court rulings in 2019.

Preliminary rulings

[The Court addressed the following preliminary rulings to the Slovenian judiciary:

- When enforcing mortgages based on a directly enforceable notarial instrument, the preventive checks by notaries cannot replace effective judicial protection. Obstacles for effective remedies against such enforcement can be, for instance, costs for legal representation, the absence of legal aid or strict conditions for the suspension of the enforcement².
- A transfer of financial instruments and other client assets between stock exchange intermediaries may
 constitute a transfer within the meaning of the Directive on transfer of undertakings where there is a
 transfer of clients³.
