# 1. MISSION STATEMENT: ACCESS TO LAW AND TO PUBLICATIONS

The task of the Publications Office is to provide direct and free-of-charge access to European law and all publications of the European Union, as well as to publish, on all media and in all formats, the publications of the institutions and other bodies of the European Union under optimum technical and financial conditions.

## 2. THIS YEAR'S CHALLENGES

The Publications Office is a centre of excellence in publishing, providing easy access and promoting re-use of EU law and other types of documents from EU institutions for the benefit of all European citizens.

The reorganisation of the Office taking effect at the beginning of 2013 is instrumental in achieving this general aim.

The traditional publication and dissemination services provided by the Office have been upgraded on the basis of state-of-the-art IT technologies.

At the same time, new working methods and brand-new services, such as the Open Data portal and the common portal are gradually being introduced.

Within this context, the main challenges ahead in 2013 are the following:

- Implement in a smooth and effective way the **new organigramme**, adapting the detailed organisational structure and streamlining workflows and internal procedures.
- Ensure the successful public launch of the **new EUR-Lex**, providing access to more than 6 million EU law items (Official Journals, legislation, case law, etc.).
- Proceed with the development of the Publications Office's **common portal**, as a single access point for all content currently available through the different websites managed by the Office.
- Continue to work on the **Open Data portal**, by including data sets from Commission services, as well as from the other EU institutions, agencies, bodies, and eventually Member States.
- Complete uploading files into the CELLAR (Common Content Repository and Common Metadata Repository), the documentary collection containing, referencing and indexing all the content published by the Office.
- Increase the production and dissemination of e-books through the EU Bookshop and other means.
- Expand the use of the **eTendering** platform to further Commission Directorates-General, and prepare access for other EU institutions, agencies and bodies.
- Step up the usage and fully exploit the potential of the **print on demand** facility.
- Pursue the efforts in providing harmonised and standardised metadata, as well as common authority tables to ensure interoperability and enhanced access, search, linking and re-use of content through **semantic technologies**.
- Contribute to the successful enlargement of the European Union to **Croatia**, with particular reference to access to legislation and to publications.

# 4.1 Production (26 AWBL<sup>2</sup>-12)

### **Description**

This activity involves publishing the Official Journal in all official languages on all media, preparing the publication of the Special Edition of the Official Journal in case of enlargement, consolidating European Union acts, making available all public procurement notices in the Supplement to the Official Journal, producing publications in all forms, reprinting publications and correcting errors for which the Office bears responsibility.

The institutions are committed to processing publication of compulsory EU documents through the Publications Office (e.g. Official Journal, the General report on the activities of the European Union). For publications of a non-compulsory nature, institutions may choose to use the services of the Publications Office.

#### Justification

The role of the Publications Office in publishing the Official Journal of the European Union and guaranteeing its authenticity is laid down in Decision 2009/496/EC, Euratom of 26 June 2009 on the organisation and operation of the Publications Office of the European Union [see article 3, paragraph 1 (a)] (OJ L 168, 30.6.2009, p. 41), amended by Decision 2012/368/EU, Euratom of 29 June 2012 (OJ L 179, 11.7.2012, p. 15).

Publication of the Official Journal is specifically mentioned in the Treaty on European Union (Articles 110, 248 and 254), Council Decision of 15 September 1958 creating the Official Journal of the European Communities (OJ 17, 6.10.1958, p. 390) and Parliament and Council Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 of 30 May 2001 on public access to European Parliament, Council and Commission documents (OJ L 145, 31.5.2001, p. 43), and in Consolidated versions of the Treaty on European Union and the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union (OJ C 115, 9.5.2008, p. 1).

Ongoing consolidation was decided by the European Council of Edinburgh, 1992.

The directives on public procurement, which determine the notices to be published and the manner in which they are published for all awarding authorities (national or regional entities and institutions), make it mandatory above specific thresholds to publish these notices in the Supplement to the Official Journal.

The activity regarding EU publications is explicitly mentioned in Decision 2009/496/EC of 26 June 2009 on the organisation and operation of the Publications Office of the European Union, amended by Decision 2012/368/EU, Euratom of 29 June 2012.



Average cost per notice and trend over time (Official Journals & Case law-6)





# 4.3 Physical distribution and promotion (26 AWBL-15)

This activity involves storing activities for publications: placing in storage, entries/removals, etc., packaging and addressing (machines, installations, consumables, handling, etc.), dispatching (mailing, transport, shuttles, etc.), as well as promoting and marketing (exhibitions, catalogues, prospectuses, etc.), and providing information and assistance to the public, essentially with respect to usage of the public websites.

# 4.4 Public websites (26 AWBL-13)

- the Decision 2009/496/EC, Euratom of 26 June 2009 on the organisation and operation of the Publications Office of the European Union, amended by Decision 2012/368/EU, Euratom of 29 June 2012.

Preserving all publications and making them available in electronic form is explicitly mentioned in Decision 2009/496/EC, Euratom, amended by Decision 2012/368/EU, Euratom of 29 June 2012.

In the context of the 7th Framework Programme, the CORDIS activities are covered by the specific programme adopted by the European Parliament and the Council in their Decision 1982/2006/EC of 18 December 2006 'Programme of the European Community for research, technological development and demonstration activities (2007-2013)' and described in Annex 4 of FP7 Cooperation Work Programme adopted by the Commission [C(2012)4536 of 9 July 2012]. 


