

**Government Decree No 474/2017 of 28 December 2017
amending Government Decree No 45/2014 of 26 February 2014 on the detailed rules of contracts concluded
between consumers and businesses**

On the basis of the authorisation given in Section 66(1)(d) of Act CLXXVII of 2013 on the transitional and authorising provisions related to the entry into force of Act V of 2013 on the Civil Code and acting within its scope of duties defined in Article 15(1) of the Basic Law, the Government orders the following:

Section 1 Section 2(i) of Government Decree No 45/2014 of 26 February 2014 on the detailed rules of contracts concluded between consumers and businesses (hereinafter referred to as the 'Government Decree') is replaced by the following:

[This Decree shall not apply to:]

"i) package travel contracts, unless otherwise provided for in Government Decree No 472/2017 of 28 December 2017 on contracts relating to travel services, in particular on contracts relating to package travel and linked travel arrangements;"

(2) The following Section 34 is added to the Government Decree:

"Section 34 Section 2(i) shall serve the purpose of compliance with the Directive on package travel and linked travel arrangements, amending Regulation (EC) No 2006/2004 and Directive 2011/83/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council and repealing Council Directive 90/314/EEC."

Section 2 This Decree shall enter into force on 1 January 2018.

Section 3 This Decree shall serve the purpose of compliance with the Directive on package travel and linked travel arrangements, amending Regulation (EC) No 2006/2004 and Directive 2011/83/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council and repealing Council Directive 90/314/EEC.
