When I came here at the start of July I didn't have a clue what was ahead of me. It was the guidance counsellor who inspired me to apply for this kind of work. There was a discussion in class about the European Year of Voluntary Work and the importance of the work volunteer workers do. She explained to us that 23% of the European community do voluntary work and that this type of work benefits not only society in general, but the worker themselves.

We had great fun singing and composing music together. Every fortnight there would be a concert for the whole camp,

both helpers and children. The children's power and enthusiasm made my heart glad. How bright and spirited all the children were made a huge impression on me. Inspite of being seriously ill, it was rare to hear them complaining; they are strong people with positive outlooks. I learnt lots from being in their company. I understand better now how valuable health is and I have a better understanding of the difficulties of these people that have a chronic illness. I would advise everyone to spend some time doing voluntary work. I intend to continue with voluntary work when I'm back in Ireland and maybe you will read about that in this magazine in the future!
