

Closure of a multiple complaint on an alleged breach by Germany of EU rules on enforcement of judgments

Reference number: CHAP(2020)1541

This communication concerns a large number of complaints regarding an alleged breach by Germany of Council Regulation (EC) 44/2001 of 22 December 2000 on jurisdiction and the recognition and enforcement of judgments in civil and commercial matters (Brussels I Regulation), which has been replaced by Regulation (EU) No 1215/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 12 December 2012 on jurisdiction and the recognition and enforcement of judgments in civil and commercial matters (Brussels Ia Regulation).

On 20 October 2022 the Commission services published a notice, justifying the proposal to close the complaint and inviting the complainants to react within four weeks from the publication of the pre-closure notice of 4th October 2022. Since no new evidence or arguments were raised by the complainants within the four weeks period, the case will be closed on the date of the publication of the present communication for the reasons explained in the Commission services notice available on the Europa website at the address below under the title: ‘Pre-closure letter for a multiple complaint on an alleged breach by Germany of EU rules on enforcement of judgments - CHAP(2020)1541’.
