## 1. INTRODUCTION

This document provides an overview of evaluations and studies finalised in 2016 as reported by the Commission's Directorates General in their 2016 Annual Activity Reports.

The document is divided into two parts: Information on Evaluations finalised in 2016 is provided in chapter 2, and information on Studies completed in 2016 is provided in chapter 3.

### Definition evaluation:

An evidence-based judgment of the extent to which an intervention has been effective and efficient; relevant given the needs and its objectives; coherent both internally and with other EU policy interventions and achieved EU added-value. The Commission is committed to evaluate in a proportionate way all EU spending and non-spending activities intended to have an impact on society or the economy. Evaluations are an essential step to manage and revise the existing body of EU legislation and policy and should precede impact assessment. Commission evaluations are carried out in line with the Better Regulation Guidelines and Toolbox<sup>1</sup>.

### Definition study:

A document resulting from intellectual services necessary to support the institution's own policies or activities. It may be produced inside the institution or commissioned from external experts, generally through procurement procedures. It is financed through the EU budget. Studies can support evaluations but they do not necessarily adhere to the requirements set out in the Better Regulation Guidelines and Toolbox.

The evaluations and studies are listed per policy area.

The table indicates the title of the evaluation/study; the reason for which the evaluation/study was carried out and its scope, and references (where available) to the document.

The 'reason' column provides for a selection of one or more from a list of options as follows:

- L - Legal act<sup>2</sup>,
- LMFF - Legal base of Multiannual Financial Framework instrument<sup>3</sup>;
