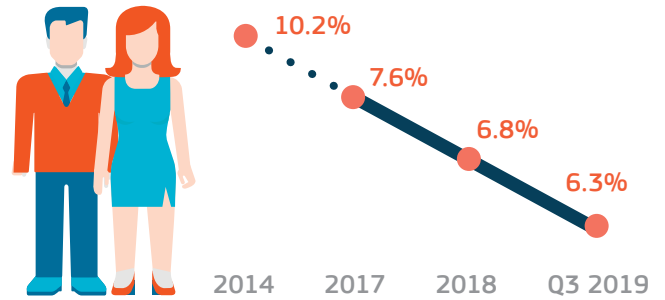

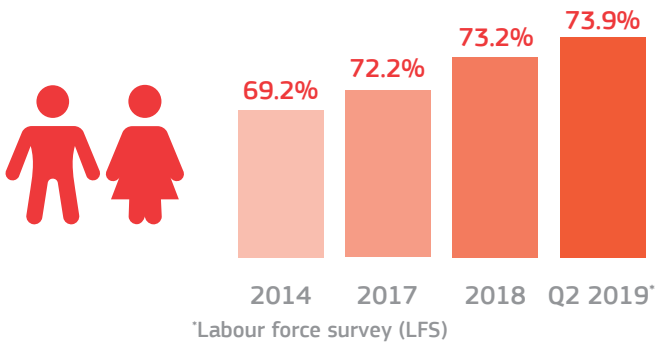

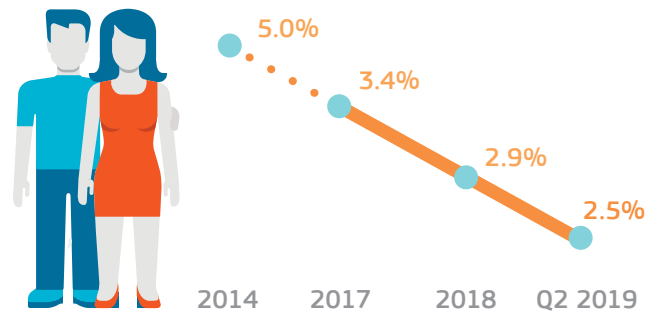
### UNEMPLOYMENT (15-74)



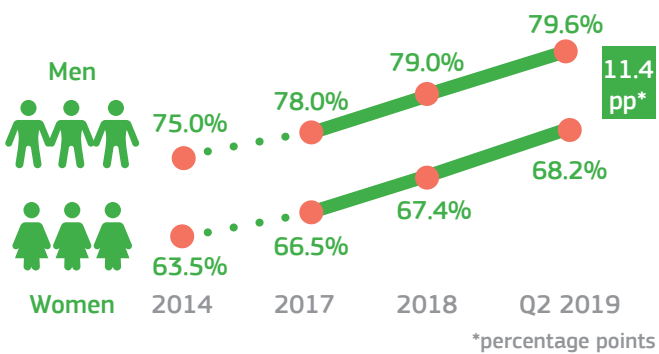
### EMPLOYMENT (20-64)



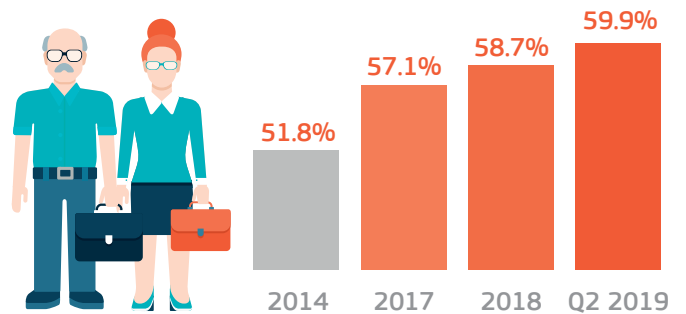
### LONG-TERM UNEMPLOYMENT



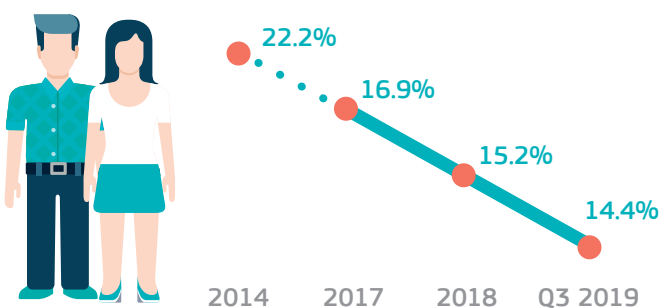
### GENDER EMPLOYMENT GAP (20-64)



### EMPLOYMENT OLDER WORKERS (55-64)

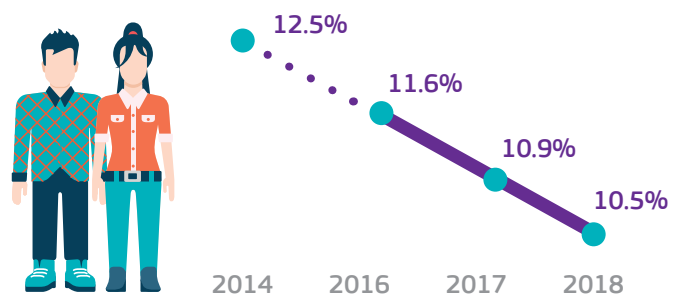


### YOUTH UNEMPLOYMENT (15-24)



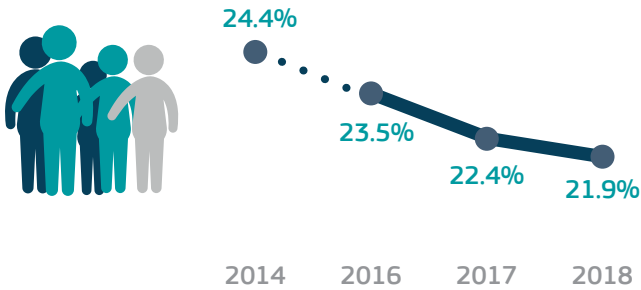

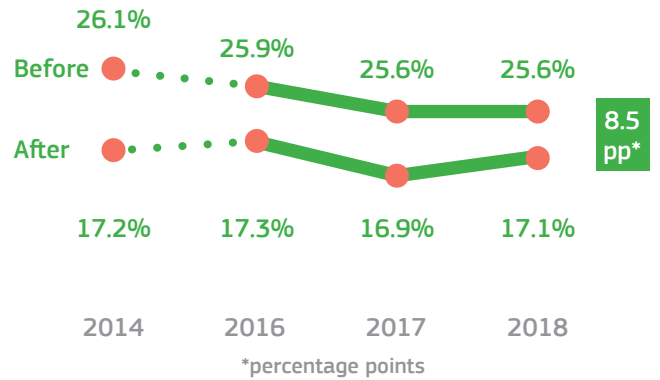

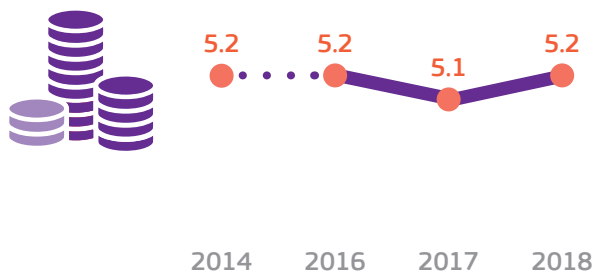
## AT RISK OF POVERTY OR SOCIAL EXCLUSION (% of population)



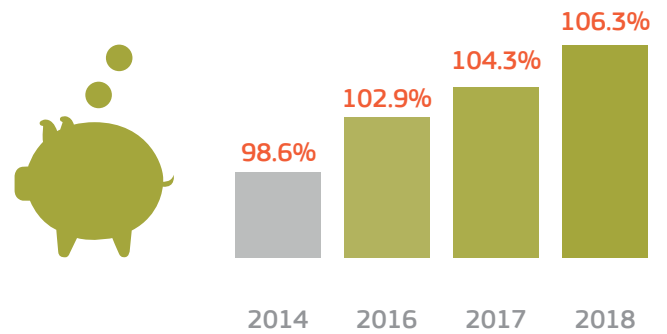
## IMPACT OF SOCIAL TRANSFERS ON POVERTY (Reduction of risk of poverty rate due to social transfers)



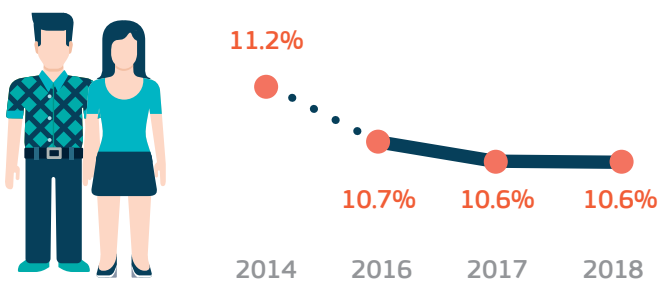
## INCOME INEQUALITY (Ratio of incomes of richest 20% of households to poorest 20%)



## HOUSEHOLD INCOME INDEX (2008=100)

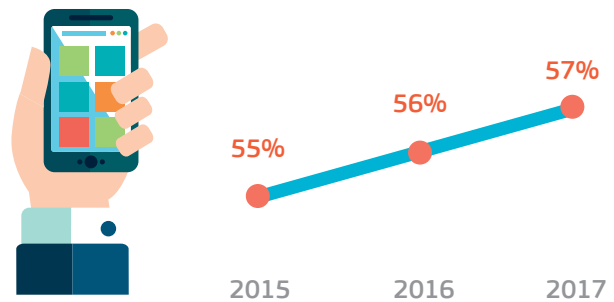


## EARLY SCHOOL LEAVERS (18-24)

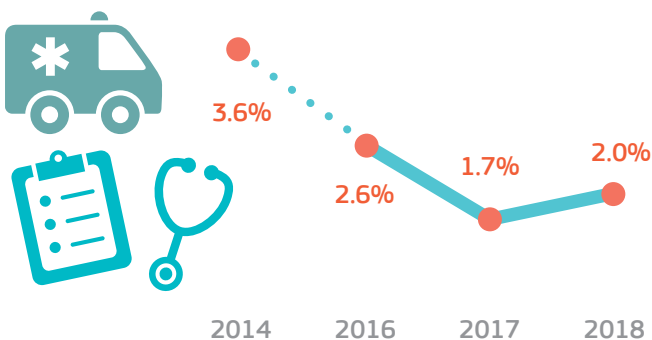


## DIGITAL SKILLS
