Conclusions

- The Project Group underlined the critical role artificial intelligence plays in safeguarding the EU's competitiveness, sovereignty, and democratic resilience.
- Europe's strengths in AI research, its dynamic startup ecosystems and ongoing
 investments in AI infrastructures were identified as key enablers to make Europe an
 AI Continent.
- The Group discussed the deployment of AI, both in terms of sectors (such as health, financial, employment, defence) and in terms of horizontal deliverables (such as AI Factories and Gigafactories, the Invest AI Facility, and providing support in the implementation of the AI Act).
- The Project Group emphasized the importance of having a clear, simple, and harmonized regulatory frameworks to foster AI adoption across all sectors, stressing the need for the effective and streamlined implementation of the AI Act.
