

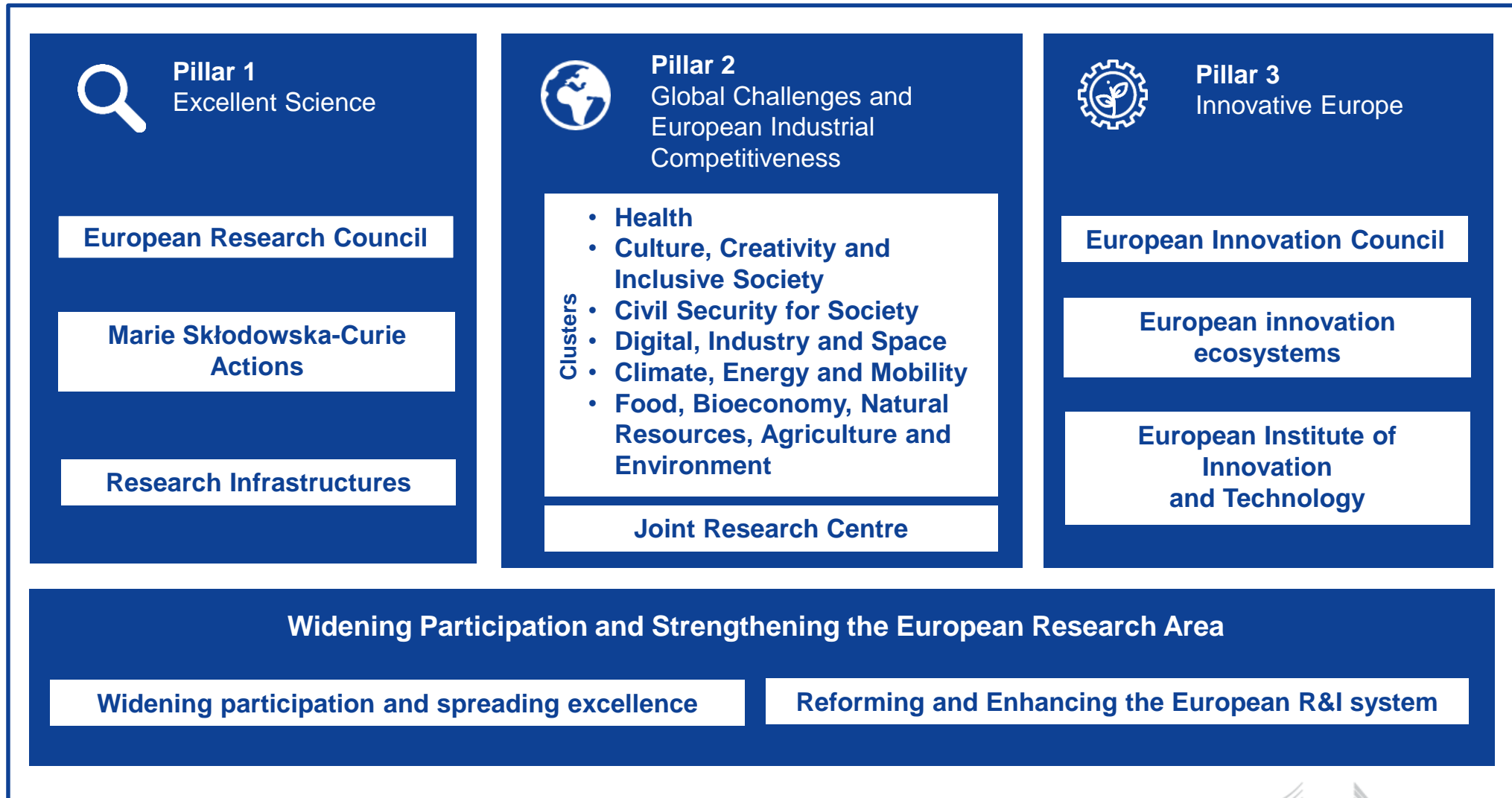

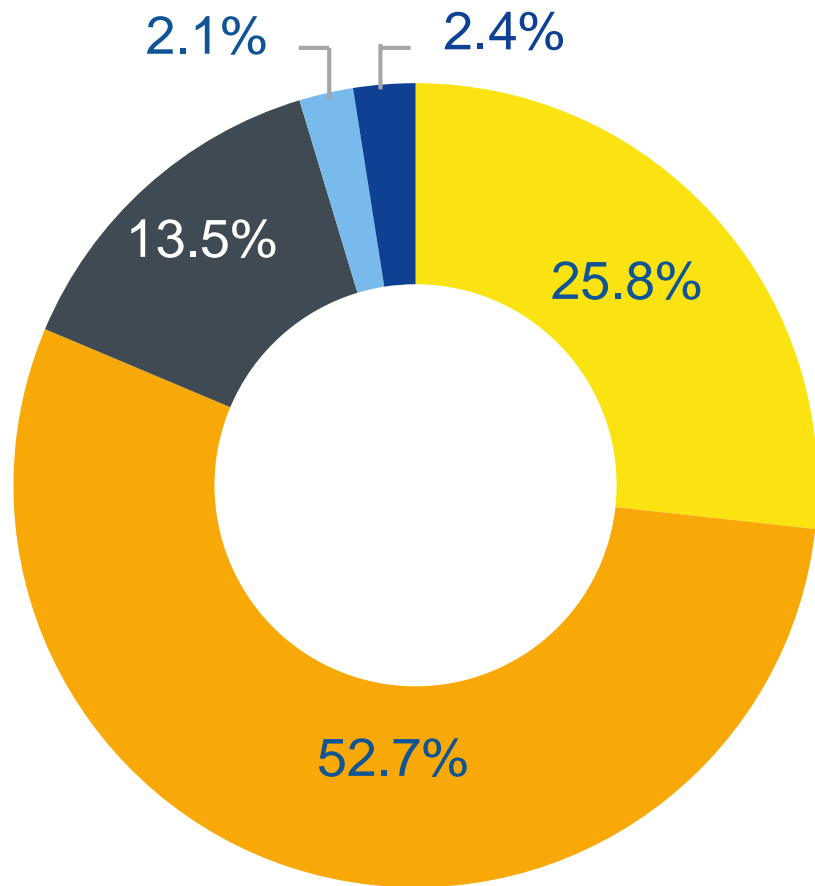

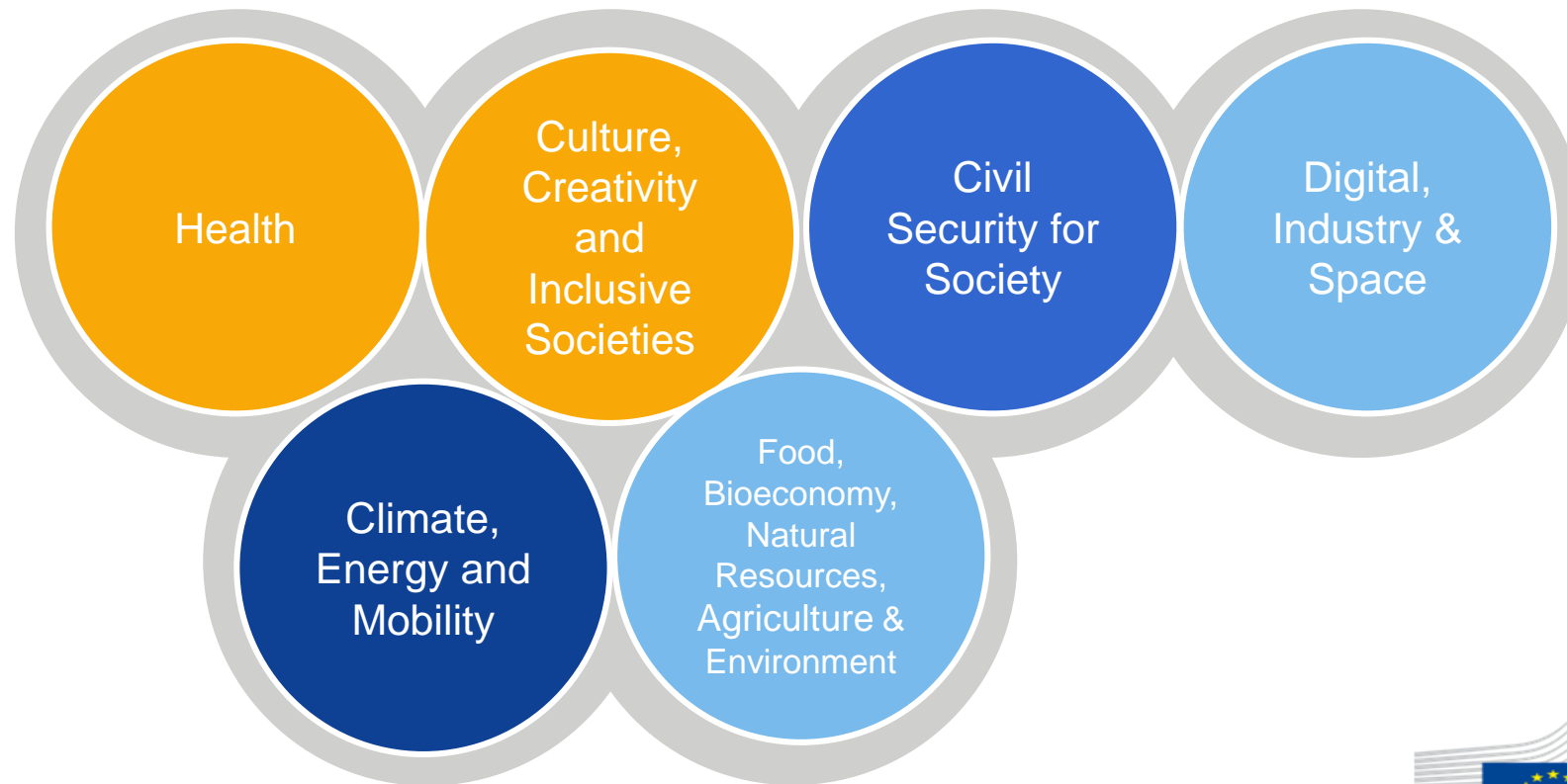

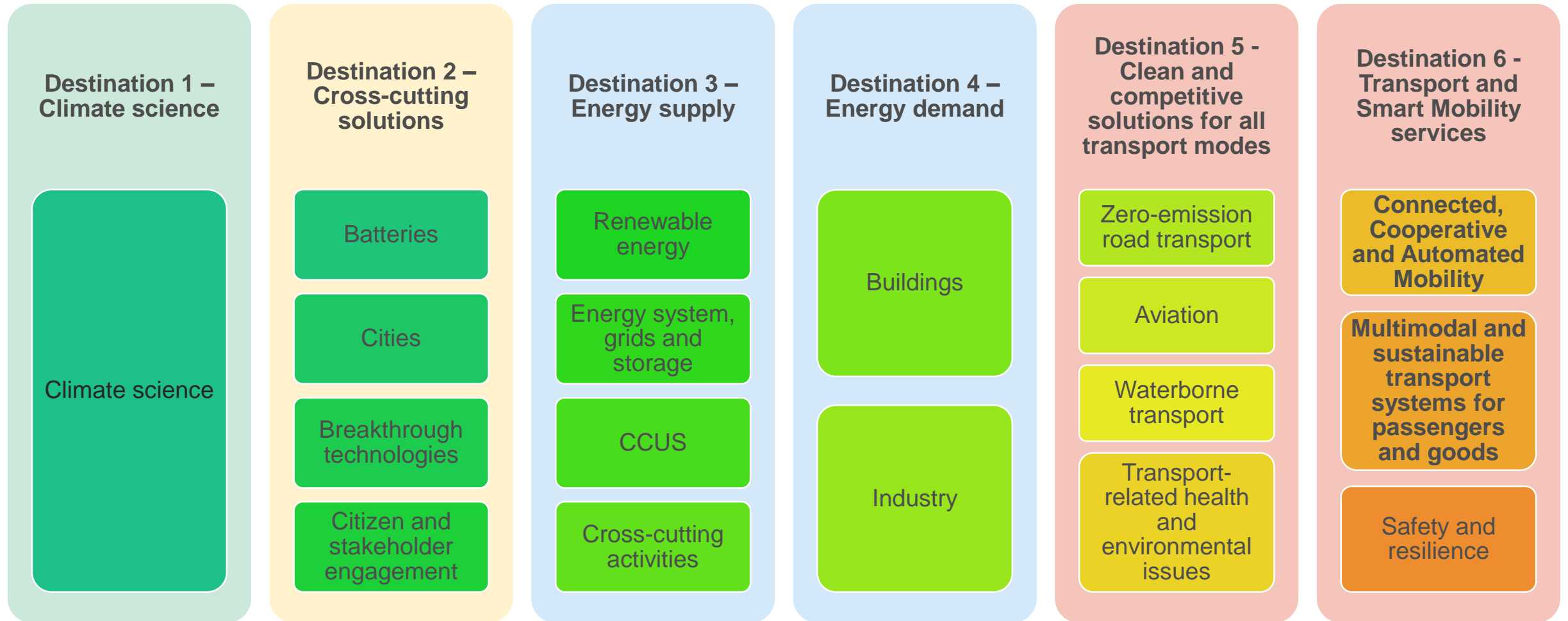

Competitiveness: boosting key technologies and solutions underpinning EU policies & Sustainable Development Goals

New approach to European Partnerships

Co-programmed

Based on Memoranda of Understanding / contractual arrangements; implemented independently by the partners and by Horizon Europe (e.g. buildings, batteries, industry)

Co-funded

Based on a joint programme agreed and implemented by partners; commitment of partners for financial and in-kind contributions (e.g. Clean Energy Transition, Driving Urban Transition)

Institutionalised

Based on long-term dimension and need for high integration; partnerships based on Articles 185 / 187 of TFEU and the EIT-Regulation supported by Horizon Europe (e.g. Hydrogen)
