



KEY PERFORMANCE INDICATORS EEN Client Journey



Enterprise Europe Network – success stories

- W•SENSE, a small Italian technology firm has pioneered the underwater Internet of Things.
- In 2017, W•SENSE developed a solution to guarantee underwater cable-less networking interoperability (this enables submarines, divers, unmanned vehicles and underwater sensors to communicate effectively with one another).







- EEN helped them obtain finance for scaling up and taking on bigger contracts (support with for drafting business plan, and for obtaining a EUguaranteed loan), and internationalization services.
- Their annual turnover multiplied by 20 in three years.



Enterprise Europe Network in figures (2019):

- The Enterprise Europe Network supported over 220,000 SMEs with intensive, high added-value services
- It reached 8,6 million SMEs through its digital service offer
- Client satisfaction rate: 88%




Moving forward: the new EEN from 2022

- Helping them to cooperate and where appropriate integrate with local, regional, national and European clusters, and industrial ecosystems and global value chains."
