Eckhard Janeba is a professor of public economics and economic policy at the University of Mannheim.

He earned his Ph.D. in Economics from the University of Bonn and held for ten years academic positions in the United States at Indiana University and the University of Colorado before returning to his native Germany.

Eckhard Janeba has been a member of the Scientific Advisory Board to the German Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Climate Action since 2007 and is serving as its chair since 2023.

From 2013 to 2018, he was Chairman of the Independent Advisory Board to the German Stability Council, Germany's independent fiscal institution.

His research focuses on public economics, particularly fiscal rules, tax policy, and political economy.
