1) European Civic Forum Response

We are active members of the **European Civic Forum** and *fully endorse* all the points raised in their submission particularly in relation to shrinking civic space.

In particular, we support the Civic Forums' recommendation that the Commission take a more comprehensive approach to the rule of law, democracy and fundamental rights rather than viewing these issue in isolation.

2) MEDEL- Europe response

We are an active partner organisation of MEDEL-Europe (Magistrats européens pour la Démocratie et la Liberté) and *fully endorse* all the points raised in their submission (see attached).

We are particularly concerned about the treatment of District Judge Monika Frarkowiak.

We interviewed Monika Frakowiak on 15 November 2020 for our Friday Casebook series and would like to submit this as evidence of the political pressure being brought to bear by the Polish

government to undermine judicial independence in Poland.
