


Writing: Beyond the Sentence





Microscopic structure of bone


- · Cancellous (spongy) bone
 - Found sandwiched between compact bone.
 - No osteons
 - Contains needle like
 Trabeculae
 - Bone cells found in trabeculae
 - Nutrients and waste passed throu
 - Bone spong




Trabecular Bone

Trabeculae: 3D Lattice








