AIR CONNECTIONS

Rome has frequent air connections with all EU capital cities and major European cities. All the capitals of the EU (with the exception of Ljubljana) can be reached via frequent direct flights, in most of the cases daily; in addition, there are numerous stopover options, making Rome one of the most easily accessible cities within the EU. Frankfurt is also connected with several flights a day, as are the main European non-EU financial centres such as London and Zurich.
