Dear Commissioner,

On behalf of Scott Schenkel, thank you for your letter of 21 April 2020. Please note that, on 27 April, Scott Schenkel was succeeded by our new CEO, Mr Jamie lannone.

We continue implementing and improving our measures to protect consumers in the face of COVID19-related fraudulent and misleading practices online, which are described in detail in our letter of 26 March.

As of today, eBay has blocked or removed more than 15 million listings from our global marketplace that violate our COVID-19 policies.

Listings or advertisements for dietary supplements claiming to have anti-viral properties are also being blocked, in close cooperation with relevant authorities. The following press release from the Italian Minister of Agriculture is an example of our actions in this field:
