**Act  
amending the Consumer Protection Act**

In accordance with the decision of the Finnish Parliament,  
Section 2(7) of Chapter 6 of the Consumer Protection Act (38/1978), as amended by Act  
1211/2013, *is repealed* and  
paragraph 1 of Section 4 of Chapter 6, as amended by Act 1211/2013, *is amended* as follows:

Chapter 6

**Doorstep selling and distance selling**

Section 4

*Application of the provisions to certain services*

Only paragraphs 2 and 3 of Section 12 and Section 25 shall apply to contracts concerning  
passenger transport services and to package travel as referred to in the Combined Travel  
Services Act (901/2017).

This Act shall enter into force on 1 July 2018.

In the case of contracts entered into before that date, the provisions which applied at the time  
of entry into force shall remain applicable.
