



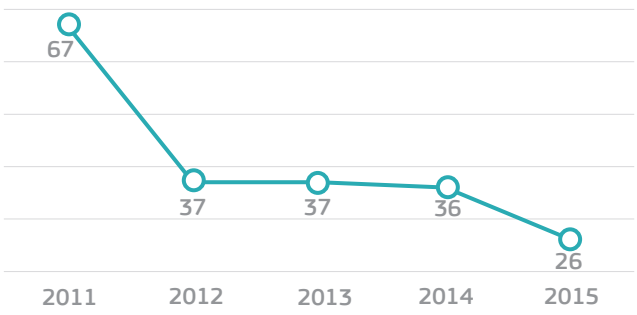

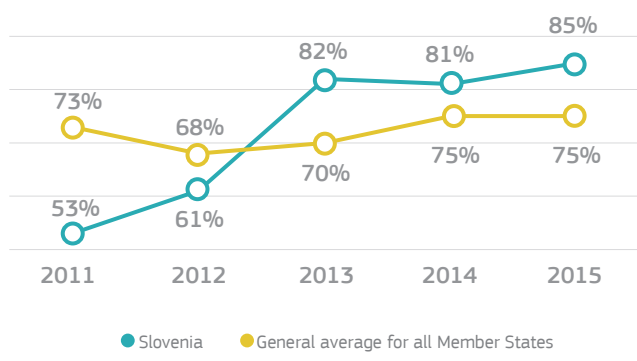
## Annual Report 2015

In 2015, new complaints against Slovenia increased more strongly but, since 2011, the decline in new EU Pilot files also accelerated. The number of open infringement cases has been stable since 2013, and new infringement cases for late transposition were unchanged from the 2014 level.

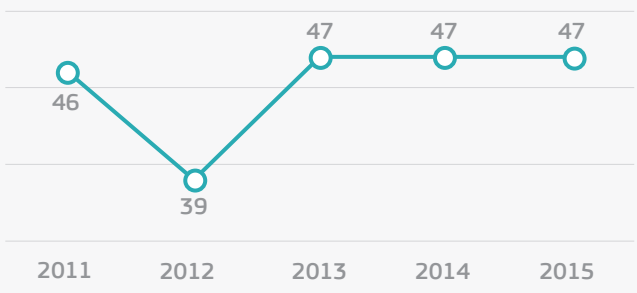
New EU Pilot files opened



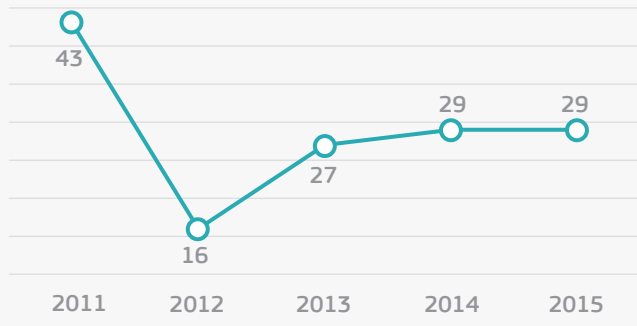
EU Pilot files: evolution of the resolution rate



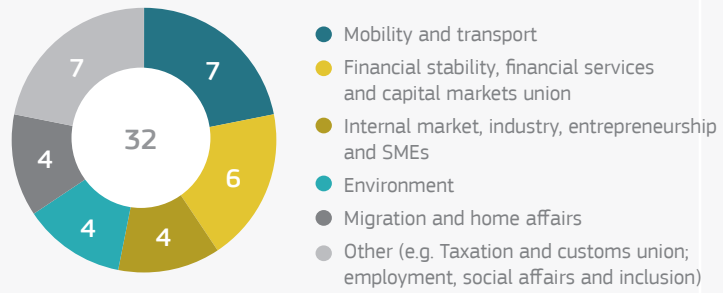

Infringement cases open on 31 December



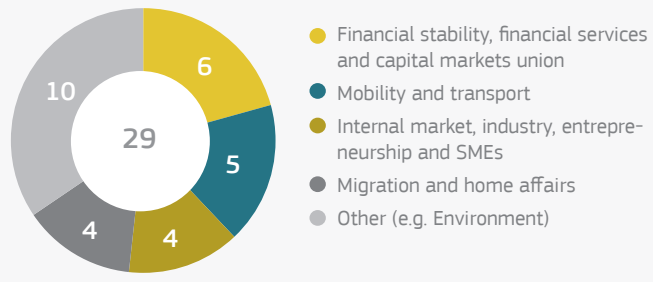
TRANSPOSITION OF DIRECTIVES

The Court ruled that:

- Slovenia has infringed the Waste Framework Directive and the Landfill Directive due to the operation of two illegal landfills in Celje.<sup>1</sup>
