



In 2015, new complaints against Slovenia increased more strongly but, since 2011, the decline in new EU Pilot files also accelerated. The number of open infringement cases has been stable since 2013, and new infringement cases for late transposition were unchanged from the 2014 level.



EU Pilot files: evolution of the resolution rate




General average for all Member States Slovenia

32 new infringement cases opened in 2015: main policy areas


