**LAW AMENDING THE CONSUMER RIGHTS
LAW OF 2013**

For the purpose of partial harmonisation with Article 27 of Directive (EU) 2015/2302 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 25 November 2015 on package travel and linked travel arrangements, amending Regulation (EC) No 2006/2004 and Directive 2011/83/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council and repealing Council Directive 90/314/EEC,
Short title. 133(I) of 2013.	The House of Representatives has decided as follows: 1. This Law shall be referred to as the Consumer Rights (Amendment) Law of 2017 and shall be read in conjunction with the Consumer Rights Law of 2013 (hereinafter referred to as ‘the basic law’) and the basic law and this Law shall be referred to jointly as the Consumer Rights Laws of 2013 and 2017.
Amendment of Article 2 of the basic law.	2. Article 2 of the basic law shall be amended by the addition, in the appropriate alphabetical order, of the following new terms and definitions:

Official Journal of the EU:	“Directive 90/314/EEC” means Council Directive 90/314/EEC of 13 June 1990 on package travel, package holidays and package tours;

<p>186(I) of 2017.</p>	<p>“package” or “package travel” shall have the meaning attributed to those terms in Article 2 of the Package Travel and Linked Travel Arrangements Law of 2017;</p>
<p>Amendment of Article 3 of the basic law.</p>	<p>“traveller” shall have the meaning attributed to that term in Article 2 of the Package Travel and Linked Travel Arrangements Law of 2017.</p>
<p>Amendment of Article 3 of the basic law.</p>	<p>3. Paragraph (g) of Article 3(3) of the basic law and references to its side heading shall be replaced by the following paragraph (g):</p>
<p>Entry into force of this Law.</p>	<p>‘(g) on packages, with the exception of Article 5(7), Article 7(2) and (6) and Articles 18, 20 and 21, which shall apply <i>mutatis mutandis</i> to packages in relation to travellers;’.</p>
<p>Entry into force of this Law.</p>	<p>4. This Law shall enter into force on 1 July 2018.</p>
