I am the founder and President of Forum Energii, a think tank dedicated to supporting the energy transition and achieving climate neutrality.

As a senior expert in energy markets, carbon markets, renewable energy, and international energy policy, I have gained extensive experience working in both Poland and Germany. I have authored and co-authored over 200 publications on energy and climate, many of which have been widely cited and have influenced key policy decisions. My work goes beyond policy recommendations—I am particularly focused on practical implementation and strategies that make the energy transition both socially acceptable and beneficial to broader areas such as energy security.

From 2007 to 2011, I held high-level positions in the Polish government, including Deputy Minister during the Polish Presidency of the EU and Head of Cabinet for the Minister. These roles gave me invaluable insights into the challenges of implementing climate and energy policy and taught me how to navigate complex political landscapes with creative solutions. Leading a think tank for eight years under a conservative, right-wing government in Poland further strengthened my ability to bridge policy and practice.

Currently, I also work at the University of Florence as part time Professor, where I contribute to academic research and policy initiatives in the field of energy and climate.

I have extensive international experience, not only through my work abroad but also as a member of various international councils, advisory bodies, and scholarship programs.

And above all—I'm a natural-born optimist.
