Virpi is also the Chair of the Banking Committee in the European Confederation of Institutes of Internal Audit (ECIIA).

Before joining ING, Virpi spent 25 years at Nordea, where she held several senior roles within Group Internal Audit. As Chief Audit Executive at Nordea, she led a team of 220 auditors across eight countries, covering the entire group and its subsidiaries. Before that, she served as Head of Operations and Country Manager for Group Internal Audit in Finland, playing a key role in driving strategic development, regulatory interaction, and operational excellence.
