QREDITS LOANS FOR SMES IN NETHERLANDS



Business loans worth in total EUR 200 million for start-ups and SMEs in the Netherlands.

In 2008, the Dutch government joined with several banks and an NGO in 2008 to found non-profit organisation Qredits to lend to SMEs. The EIB loan facility backed by the EFSI will ensure that Qredits can continue its work over the next three years, and it complements Dutch public and private sector funding.
