

Late transposition¹ infringement cases open as of 31 December 2018




New infringement cases opened in 2018: main policy areas

New late transposition infringement cases opened in 2018



1. Number of infringement cases due to failure to implement an EU Directive into national law on time.



In preliminary rulings, the Court held, amongst others, that an application for international protection must not be regarded as manifestly unfounded when, firstly, it is apparent from the information on the applicant's country of origin that acceptable protection can be ensured for him in that country and, secondly, the applicant has provided insufficient information to justify the grant of international protection².
