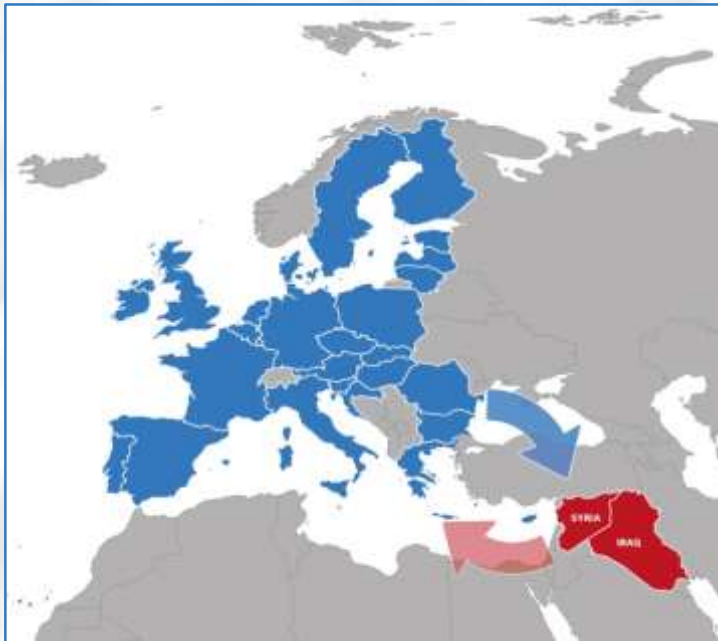

## TERRORISM: SECURITY CHALLENGE

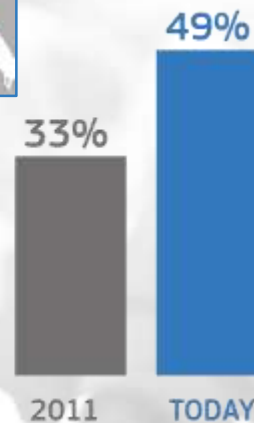


According to Europol, there might be up to **5,000 jihadists from Europe** fighting in Syria, Iraq and other conflict zones.

On 1 July 2015, Europol launched the European Union Internet Referral Unit to combat terrorist propaganda and related violent extremist activities on the internet



#### **European Counter Terrorist Centre**

A secure centre for information exchange among national law enforcement authorities
