Biography: Lucian Dan Vlădescu

President - Audit Authority, Court of Auditors, Romania



Mr. Vlădescu assumed office as President of the Audit Authority within the Romanian Court of Accounts on 15th October 2017 for a 9-year term, in accordance with the Resolution of the Parliament of Romania.

He graduated from the University of Bucharest Law School in 1995 and, at the end of his first academic year, between 2nd July - 2nd August 1992, he attended the Summer Institute in Transnational Law organized by Université Libre de

Brussels and Duke University. This experience represented his first contact with Brussels, which ultimately offered him the possibility to acquire a new approach towards Western society and European institutions.

In October 1995, he was admitted to the Bucharest Bar, and then practiced as a lawyer in the field of civil and commercial law up until May 2012, when he was appointed President of the Romanian National Authority for Regulating and Monitoring Public Procurement, under the direct coordination of the Prime Minister of Romania.

Commencing July 2013, upon leaving the Romanian National Authority for Regulating and Monitoring Public Procurement, he reassumed the role of lawyer until he began his current position.

Meanwhile, he acted as honorary advisor to the Romanian Ministry of Justice between August 2013 November 2015 and has been a trainer at the National Institute for Training and Improvement of Lawyer since 2017.
