

**Acknowledgement of receipt
of complaint No CHAP/2010/19**

1. The European Commission has received and registered under No CHAP/2010/19 a series of complaints about the non-remuneration of non-doctors undergoing specialised medical training in Italy.
2. Given the significant number of complaints it has received on this subject, the Commission, with a view to responding swiftly and informing those concerned while making the most economical use of its administrative resources, is publishing this acknowledgment of receipt in the Official Journal of the European Union and on the Internet at:

3. The complaint is currently being examined by the Commission in the light of Directive 2005/36/EC on the recognition of professional qualifications, and in particular Article 25(3) of that Directive, which provides that trainee specialised doctors must receive appropriate remuneration.
4. The complainants will be informed, through the same channels, of the results of this examination and of any follow-up action that the Commission may decide to take.
