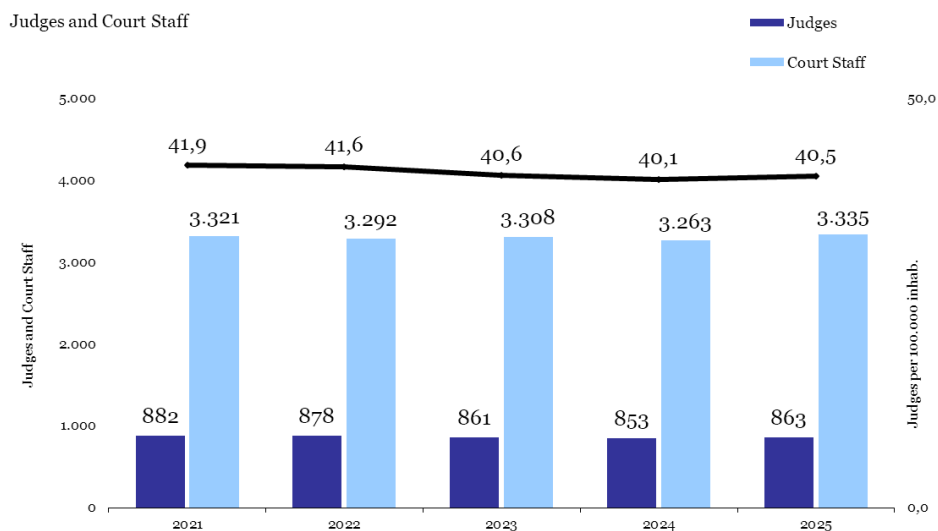

Average duration of proceedings (in months)

District Courts / Commercial cases - average duration of proceedings in 2025 (gospodarske zadeve pred okroznim sodiscem: Pg) = **12,5 m**

District Courts / Civil cases - average duration of proceedings in 2025 (pravdne zadeve pred okroznim sodiscem: P) = **24,9 m**

District Courts/Criminal cases - average duration of proceedings in 2025 (kazenske zadeve pred okroznim sodiscem) = **22,9 m**

Procedural phases: time from the beginning until the first hearing in 2025 in commercial cases (cas od vložitve tozbe do prve obravnave v Pg zadevah) = **16,1 m**

Procedural phases: time from the beginning until the first hearing in 2025 in civil cases (cas od vložitve tozbe do prve obravnave v P zadevah pred okroznimi sodisci) = **21,1 m**

ADR

In 2025, mediation was offered in total 13.588 cases in all courts and instances (in commercial cases, mediation was offered in 3.009 cases (55% of incoming commercial cases) in first instance – district courts and in 170 cases (17% of incoming commercial cases) in second instance – higher courts). In 2025, 3.035 mediations started in all courts for all types of cases (incoming mediations) and 2.981 mediations were concluded (mediation case resolved) – the data breakdown by type of cases is not available.

Functioning of courts when dealing with bribery cases

In the table below, please insert the number of resolved cases and the average length of cases before first instance criminal courts involving offence of bribery^[1], in which the judgment of the first instance court was delivered in 2023.

Please calculate the average length of proceedings for each year by first calculating the length for each individual first instance court case, then adding the numbers together and dividing them by the total number of resolved bribery cases at first instance courts.

For length, please take into account natural days and not only working days.

Both the day on which the criminal charge became final before the first instance court and the day on which the first instance court delivered the judgment should be included in the length for each individual case from which the average length for all cases is calculated.

Number of cases resolved by court of first in year of reference (resolved with a conviction or acquittal or in another way): 249

Average number of days between the day when the criminal charge (indictment) becomes final and adoption of a judgment by the criminal courts of first instance: 574

Notes:

- All resolved cases in Local and District courts with at least one bribery criminal offence were taken into account (in one case, court can decide on multiple criminal offences).
 - Individual criminal offences are set in articles/paragraphs of the Criminal code (Kazenski zakonik - KZ-1). Bribery criminal offences were selected according to the selection of criminal offences for reporting data to Slovenian Commission for the Prevention of Corruption (KPK). In 2024, the selection for reporting was changed, according to KPK notice. The data above (for 2025) is reported in accordance with 2024 changes.
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- Most of the cases were handled by Local courts (approx 77%).
- Duration is calculated from receiving criminal charge (indictment) at the court to the resolution of case (court decision is sent to parties).
