Yesterday, the local wine co-operative received a visit from a group of students from the small city of Valmiera, Latvia. Due to the fact that they are under-age, our young Baltic visitors couldn't have any wine, which is very strong in this part of La Mancha because of the amount of sunshine the grapes get. However, the smell of must, which had started to ferment in the enormous metal containers was already heady when Emilio, one of the teachers who organized the visit, announced at the top of

his voice, that it was time to eat. In a room beside the wine cellar, where wine tastings are normally held for guests, the people in charge of the co-operative organized a tasting of products made in the region. Sheep's cheese, cured ham, olives and ratatouille, a typical speciality of ours and favourite amongst the Labrians, although their eyes popped out of their heads when they found out its only ingredients are olive oil, salt, pepper, fried tomato and a pinch of sugar.

After the visit, Emilio, a teacher from Calatrava Comprehensive School, and Ivetta, a teacher from the Vocational School in Valmiera, spoke to us about how enriching the experience
