

Closure of multiple complaint case CHAP (2017)1197

A notice of acknowledgement of receipt and information about pre-closure of multiple complaint CHAP (2017)1197, regarding the adoption of regional Law 2/2016 of 27 September amending tourism planning legislation on La Gomera, La Palma and El Hierro (Canary Islands, Spain), was published on Europa website¹ on 25 October 2017. That notice informed that, after assessment of the available information, the Commission's services had concluded that the above-mentioned case could be closed. However, the complainants were invited to send to the Commission, within the four weeks that followed the publication of the notice, any new information that might demonstrate the existence of an infringement of European Union law. The notice also stated that the Commission might close the case, once the above-mentioned period had passed.

Given that the European Commission has not received any new information from the complainants within the indicated time period from the publication of the notice of acknowledgement of receipt and information about pre-closure, and for the reasons explained therein, the Commission hereby confirms that the multiple complaint case CHAP (2017)1197 is closed on the date of publication of this notice.
