

- Positive preliminary assessment adopted by COM on 8 February 2022







CZ payment request – planned calendar

EFC (and EPC) discussions (3 weeks)	10 February - 1 March (Friday-Wednesday)
Comitology meeting	9 March (Thursday)

- The Commission has sent its preliminary assessment of Czechia's fulfilment of the milestones and targets required for this payment to the Economic and Financial Committee (EFC), asking for its opinion.
- This will be followed up by detailed **discussions with the Member States** in the EFC. The EFC's opinion is to be delivered within maximum four weeks.
- Once the examination by the EFC is completed, the Commission would be in position to adopt a decision which, taken account of the EFC opinion, will authorise the disbursement of the financial contribution and disburse €928.2 million to Czechia.
- The examination comitology procedure will be used for this adoption.






Timeline and process of payment requests

Submission of the payment request (up to twice a year)



- MS chooses the best moment to submit
- All evidence in FENIX, the RRF IT Tool
- Informal cooperation with Commission ahead of submission

Commission Assessment of the payment request (up to 2 months)



 Thorough check of the satisfactory fulfilment of milestones and targets



EFC opinion (up to 4 weeks except emergency break)

- Commission provides positive preliminary assessment
- Economic Policy Committee discussion
- Economic and Financial Committee opinion adopted by consensus

Commission adopts payment decision in comitology (around 2-3 weeks)



 Opinion by RRF (comitology) Committee Commission processes payment (without undue delay)

 As soon as possible based on market conditions
