Anke D'Angelo, a dual Swiss and German national, joined the World Bank Group on October 1, 2018, as the Vice President and Auditor General for Group Internal Audit (GIA). In this capacity, Anke leads the World Bank Group's efforts to strengthen governance, risk management, and controls. She reports to the World Bank Group's President and is under the oversight of the Audit Committee.

Anke has extensive experience connecting the first, second, and third lines across multiple functions. Previously, she served in several senior leadership positions with Swiss Re, a leading wholesale provider of reinsurance, insurance, and other insurance-based forms of risk management, including in the Finance, Risk Management, Internal Audit, Compliance, and Business Governance departments. As Chief Compliance Officer, Anke introduced compliance assurance services, strengthened the compliance risk assessment methodology, and oversaw risk frameworks regarding anti-money laundering, anti-bribery and corruption, insider trading, code of conduct, and international trade controls. She was also heavily involved in the promotion of integrity during her 24-year career with Swiss Re.

She holds a master's in business administration from the Ludwig-Maximilians-University in Munich, Germany. She is fluent in English and German and speaks some French and Italian.
