Notes:

1. All of the products listed above shall comply with the applicable essential health and safety requirements laid down in Annex II of Regulation (EU) 2016/425.

2. All items regarding which the manufacturer claims protection against harmful biological agents shall be considered as PPE of category III pursuant to Annex I, category III, point c of Regulation (EU) 2016/425.

However, it cannot be excluded that certain PPE products, which are not designed specifically to provide protection against harmful biological agents may also be used in the COVID-19 context. In the case of such products, further discussion on their respective categorisation would need to take place in the framework of the Commission Expert Group on Personal Protective Equipment. The outcome of such discussions would then be reflected in a subsequent updated version of this document.
