

Closure letter for a multiple complaint about Germany's application of national minimum wage rules to road transport services - CPLT(2015)00227

This communication from the Commission services concerns the multiple complaint about Germany's application of national minimum wage rules to drivers of road transport companies established in other Member States ¹. These complaints were registered under the reference CPLT(2015)00227 ².

Since no new evidence nor new arguments were raised by the complainants following the publication of the Commission services assessment on the 12 of March 2024 on the Commission's website, the case will be closed at the date of the publication of the present communication for the reasons explained in the Commission services communication about the pre-closure of this complaint available in the Europa website at the address below under the title "Pre-closure letter for a multiple complaint about Germany's application of national minimum wage rules to road transport services - CPLT(2015)00227":
