Financial framework of the EU Trust Fund for Africa

Resources currently allocated to the EU Trust Fund for Africa amount to over **EUR 3.1 billion**.

The EU made available **EUR 2.9 billion** from the European Development Fund (EDF) and other EU financial instruments.

EU Member States and other donors (Switzerland and Norway) pledged **EUR 234 million** out of which **EUR 175.4 million** have been paid so far.
