## Pledges confirmed by the international community for the people in Türkiye and Syria

On 20 March 2023, the international community gathered in Brussels to collect funds in post-earthquakes' support for the people in Türkiye and Syria. The preliminary damage assessment for Türkiye suggests very substantial needs, above USD 100 billion.

The tables below present the pledges made in the context of this international conference.

### The international community confirmed EUR 7 billion in grants and loans

The funds for Türkiye will be used to cover humanitarian needs but also help in the reconstruction of the regions that were most affected by the earthquakes. In Syria, the funds will be used to cover humanitarian needs and support early recovery and resilience, helping Syrians to rebuild their lives.

Where pledges were provided in a currency other than euro, the European Central Bank (ECB) reference rates of 15/03/23 were used for presentation purposes only.

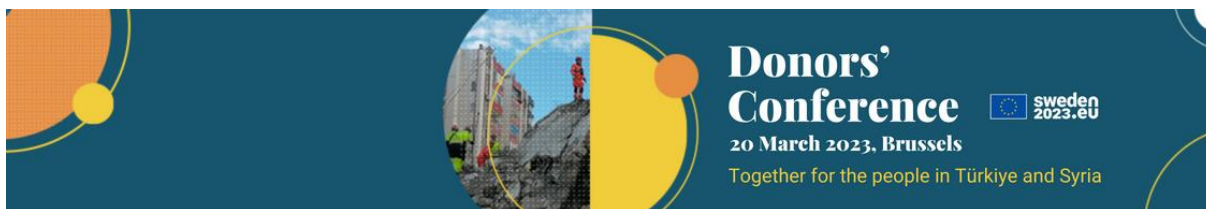

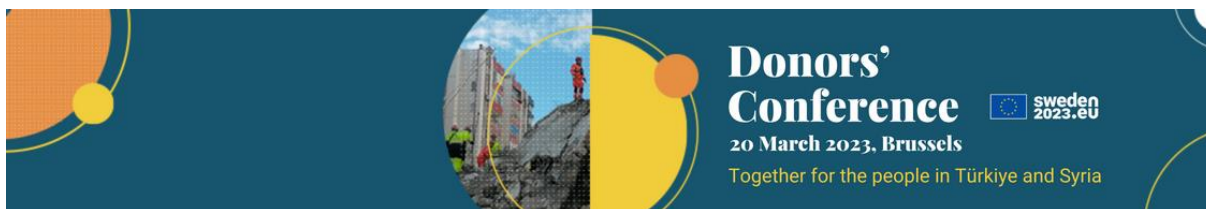

In addition to grants, multilateral development banks (MDBs), and a bilateral donor pledged EUR 4.3 billion of loans for reconstruction in Türkiye. The terms of these loans are yet to be agreed.
