## **Notification Art. 33 CRD**

National provisions going beyond Art. 5(1) to (3) and Art. 7(1) of Directive 1999/44/EC on certain aspects of the sale of consumer goods and associated guarantees

## **General Law on Consumer and User Protection**

Article 123(1), first paragraph:

The seller is responsible for any lack of conformity that becomes apparent within two years of delivery.

Article 123(4):

Action to demand compliance with the provisions of Chapter II of this title shall expire three years from the time of delivery.

Article 123(5):

The consumer or user must inform the seller of the lack of compliance within two months of becoming aware of this. Failure to comply with this deadline will not involve loss of the corresponding right to a remedy, however the consumer or user is responsible for any damage actually caused by a delay in communication.
