Part I: Programme Statements of operational expenditure

Working Document I contains Programme Statements, which constitute the main instrument for justifying the operational appropriations requested by the Commission in the Draft Budget. These Statements are coherent with the corresponding legal bases and provide details on the resources which are dedicated to each spending Programme.

Each Statement has the same structure and includes numerical data related to the Programme, EU added value and contribution to the Europe 2020 Strategy (Headline targets, Flagship initiatives) as well as mainstreaming of climate change, general objective(s) accompanied by impact indicators and targets, specific objectives supported by result indicators and targets, and expenditure related outputs, all this classified according to the MFF Headings.

Part II: Commission Human Resources

Working Document II presents information on human resources, both for the establishment plans and for external personnel, across all headings of the multiannual financial framework.

Part III: Bodies set up by the European Union and having legal personality and Public-private partnership

Working Document III presents detailed information relating to all decentralised agencies, executive agencies and Public-Private Partnerships (joint undertakings), with a transparent presentation of revenue, expenditure and staff levels of various Union bodies which actually receive a contribution charged to the EU budget, pursuant to Articles 208 and 209 of the Financial Regulation.

Part IV: Pilot projects and preparatory actions

Working Document IV presents information on all pilot projects and preparatory actions which have budget appropriations (commitments and/or payments) in the 2014 Draft Budget, pursuant to Article 38(3)(c) of the Financial Regulation.

Part V: Budget implementation and assigned revenue

Working Document V presents the budget implementation forecast for 2013, information on assigned revenue implementation in 2012, and a progress report on outstanding commitments (RAL) and managing potentially abnormal RAL (PAR) for 2012.

Part VI: Administrative expenditure under Heading 5

This document encompasses administrative expenditure under all budgets to be implemented by the Commission in accordance with Article 317 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, as well as the budgets of the Offices (OP, OLAF, EPSO, OIB, OIL and PMO).

Part VII: Commission buildings (Section III)

Working Document VII presents information on buildings under Section III - Commission, both for the Commission and for the bodies set up by the EU and having legal personality, pursuant to Article 203(3) of the Financial Regulation.

Part VIII: Expenditure related to the external actions of the European Union

Working Document VIII presents information on human resources and expenditure related to the external actions of the European Union.

Part IX: Funding to international organisations

Working Document IX presents funding provided to international organisations, across all MFF headings, pursuant to Article 38(3)(d) of the Financial Regulation.

Part X: Financial Instruments

Working Document X presents the use made of financial instruments, pursuant to Article 38(5) of the Financial Regulation.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

1. ADMINISTRATIVE RESOURCES

The European External Action Service (EEAS), fully aware of the severe economic and financial constraints facing the European Union, has based its draft budget for 2014 on a rigorous approach and a search for economy across the board.

In particular, the EEAS has cut appropriations relating to staff expenditure by reducing by 1 % the number of posts in the establishment plan and implementing a series of other measures like the downgrading of senior level posts, reductions in the Living Conditions Allowance and Rest Leaves, reduction in appropriations for external personnel and the incorporation of other savings resulting from the proposal by the Commission for amending the Staff Regulation.

Following the end of the two-year grace period in November 2013, during which no rent is paid for the EEAS headquarters building, there is an associated increase of EUR 12 million in real estate expenditure in 2014, which accounts for an increase of 2,4 % of the total EEAS budget in relation to budget 2013. Consequently, an effort has been made in other types of expenditure in order to compensate the one-off increase stemming from this particular circumstance.

For 2014, the Commission request in appropriations for delegations decreases under heading 5 (including OLAF) by 1,76 % and is quite stable under other headings (+ 0,46 %). The Commission human resources in delegations increase under heading 5: a total of + 2 officials coming from the Headquarters (including OLAF), and + 10 external personnel resulting, after a cut of 1 %, mainly from a redistribution of personnel and appropriations ending in a reinforcement of several DG's (following the conclusions of the Workload Assessment of the Delegations).

The overall request for delegations amounts to EUR 977,6 million (including EUR 76 million from the European Development Fund (EDF)), 2 345 posts and 4 986 Full-time equivalent (FTE) (including 882 FTE for the EDF). Compared to the budget 2013 this represents an increase in appropriations of 1,4 % and a reduction of 7 posts and 59 FTE.

Point 1.1 of the present working document accounts for the current situation of human resources as of 1 April 2013 on the basis of data reported by the EEAS. Point 1.2 accounts for the EEAS administrative expenditure in 2012 and point 1.3 accounts for the external action administrative resources (including expenditure on administrative management) for 2014 on the basis of data reported respectively by the EEAS and the Commission.

2. OPERATIONAL APPROPRIATIONS

As regards the Commission, expenditure 2012 and 2013 related to the external action of the EU are mainly covered by the legislative instruments which underpin the core external relations policies: the Pre-accession Assistance Instrument (IPA), the European Neighbourhood and Partnership Instrument (ENPI), the Development Cooperation Instrument (DCI), the Instrument for Cooperation with Industrialised and other High-income Countries (ICI/ICI+) and the European Instrument for Democracy and Human Rights (EIDHR). These main geographic and "policy-driven" financing instruments are complemented by instruments designed to address specific needs and in particular to provide a response to crisis situations: the Instrument for Stability (IfS), the Instrument for Nuclear Safety Cooperation (INSC), the Civil Protection Financial Instrument (CPFI), Humanitarian Aid, Macro-Financial Assistance (MFA), and the Common Foreign and Security Policy (CFSP).

In the new programmes for the 2014-2020 period, the Commission proposes to update these main geographic and thematic instruments, notably the Instrument for Pre-accession Assistance (IPA II), the European Neighbourhood Instrument (ENI), the Development Cooperation Instrument (DCI), the European Instrument for Democracy and Human Rights (EIDHR), the Instrument for Stability (IfS) and the Instrument for Nuclear Safety Cooperation (INSC). In addition, the Commission has proposed the creation of a new instrument – the Partnership Instrument (PI) – to complement the current array of instruments. This Instrument is the successor of the financial instrument for cooperation with industrialised and other high income countries (ICI/ICI+).

In the course of 2013 the Commission completed the pilot projects to establish the European Voluntary Humanitarian Aid Corps EU Aid Volunteers (EUAV). As required by Article 214(5) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union (TFEU), the Commission has proposed the new legal base for the EUAV, which will be funded as of 2014.

More detailed information is provided in the Working Document I.

The overall amounts provided in the section 2 include the operational appropriations as well as the administrative expenditure covered by the so-called BA lines supporting the different mentioned instruments.

1.3.3. Requested evolution in establishment plan posts at Headquarters and in delegations

- (1) For 2014, the EEAS is proposing:
 - to cut by 1% the number of posts in its establishment plan, through a reduction at headquarters of 9 AST 6 and 8 AST5 posts;
 - to downgrade a number of senior level posts in its establishment plan. 5 AD16 and 9 AD15 posts should be transformed into 9 AD7 and 5 AD5 posts. The footnote to the EEAS establishment plan which mentions that “*the establishment plan accepts the following ad personam appointments: 2 AD15 become AD16; 3 AD14 become AD15; 1 AD13 becomes AD14*” will be deleted;
 - to transform 4 AST7 posts into 4 AD7 posts in delegations to reinforce their administrative capacity; to transform 6 AST5 and 6 AST6 posts into 6 AD5 and 6 AD6 posts at headquarters in order to meet the requirement for political and more conceptual tasks. Such transformations are budget neutral.
- (2) In addition, 10 posts will be transferred from the Council in parallel to the transfer of tasks regarding secure IT systems, whereas 2 AST 6 posts will be transferred from the EEAS to PMO along with the transfer of tasks related to the management of family allowances (annex 7 of the staff regulations) for EEAS staff. This is budget neutral for the EU as a whole.

2.2. Operational appropriations requested for 2013 and 2014

In the draft budget 2014, expenditure related to the external action of the EU sees a decrease in commitment appropriations of -12,5 % to EUR 8 175,8 million, leaving an unallocated margin of EUR 159,2 million available under the ceiling. Payment appropriations decrease by -8,2 % to EUR 6 251,3 million.
