


#### Infringement cases open as of 31 December 2018

#### Relevant rulings of the European Courts:

In preliminary rulings, the Court held, amongst others, that EU citizens have the right to be accompanied or joined by their non-EU national family members when returning to their home Member State after having exercised free movement rights in another Member State. EU citizens must have exercised free movement rights genuinely and effectively in another Member State, and must have created or strengthened family life there, before they can invoke similar rights of entry and residence for their family members<sup>2</sup>.
