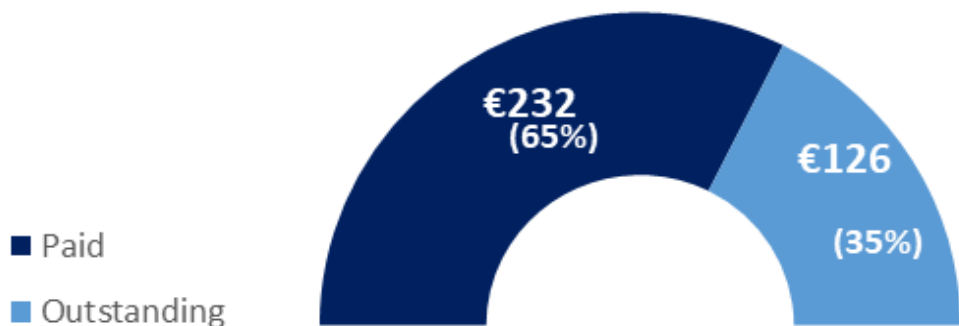

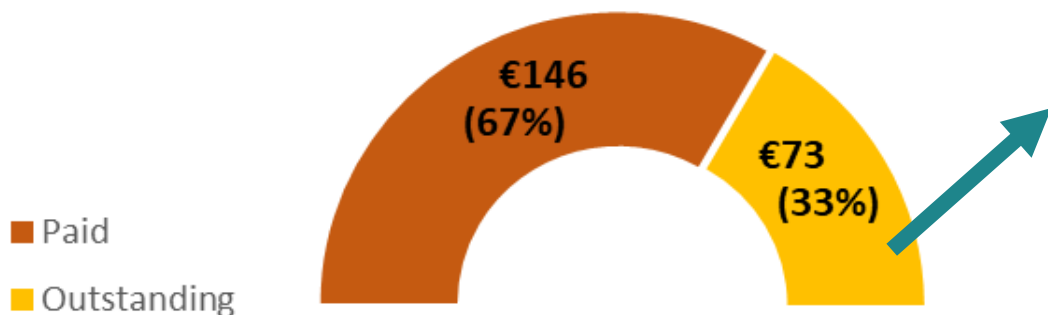
# State of play after simplification wave

## RRF Loan Disbursements (out of €219 bn)

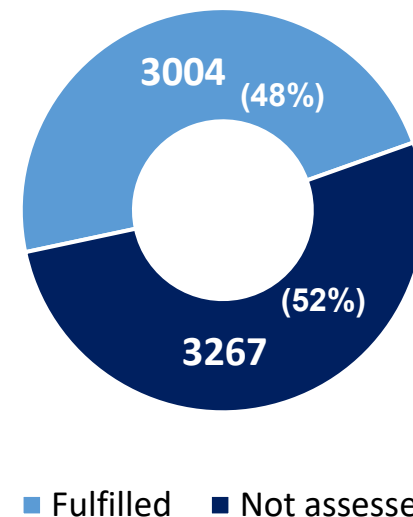


Reduction in the loan envelope by €72.5 bn (25%)

### Reduction in the number of M&Ts by 19% overall:

- **7 Member States** cut the number of M&Ts still to be assessed by **more than 1/4**.
- **9 Member States** cut the number of outstanding M&Ts by **at least 20%**.

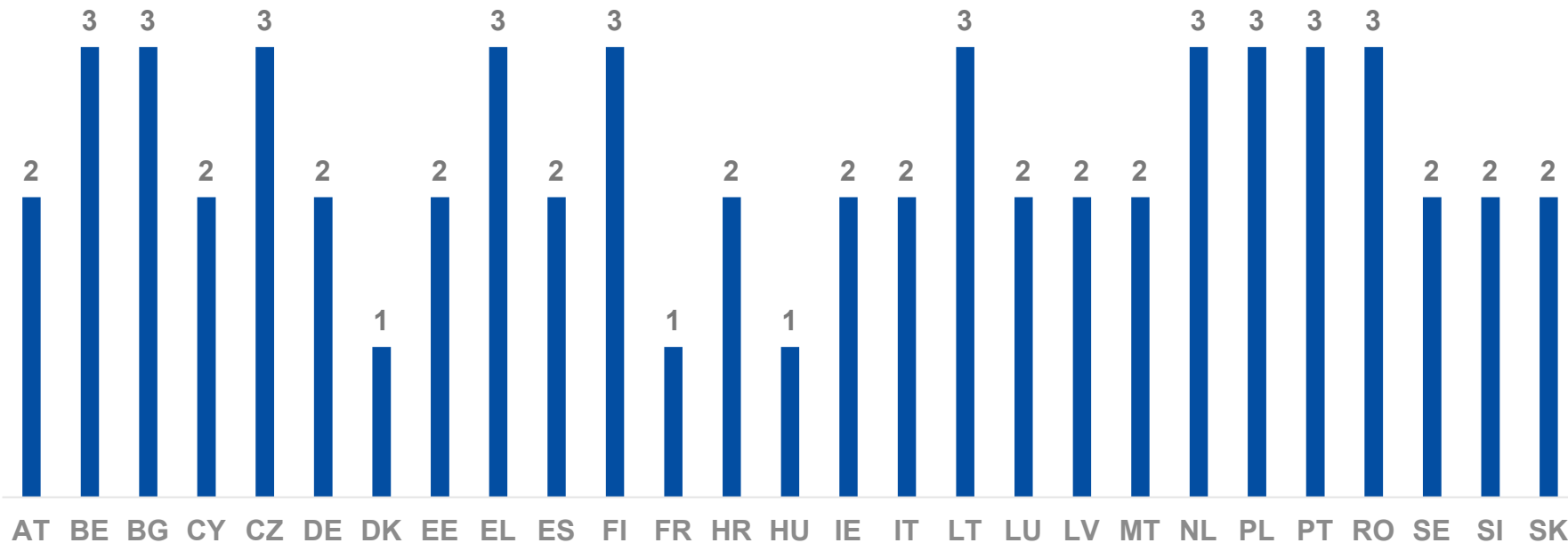
## M&Ts assessed as fulfilled

# A significant increase in the pace of disbursement is expected in 2026

Number of payment requests expected to be disbursed in 2026



- Most Member States will receive the disbursement of **two or three payment requests** in 2026
- We anticipate to disburse **€182 billion in 2026**, with around **two-thirds of this amount allocated to the second half of the year**

NB: The figures indicated in the graph account for payment requests already submitted and not disbursed by the end of this year or that will be submitted in 2026

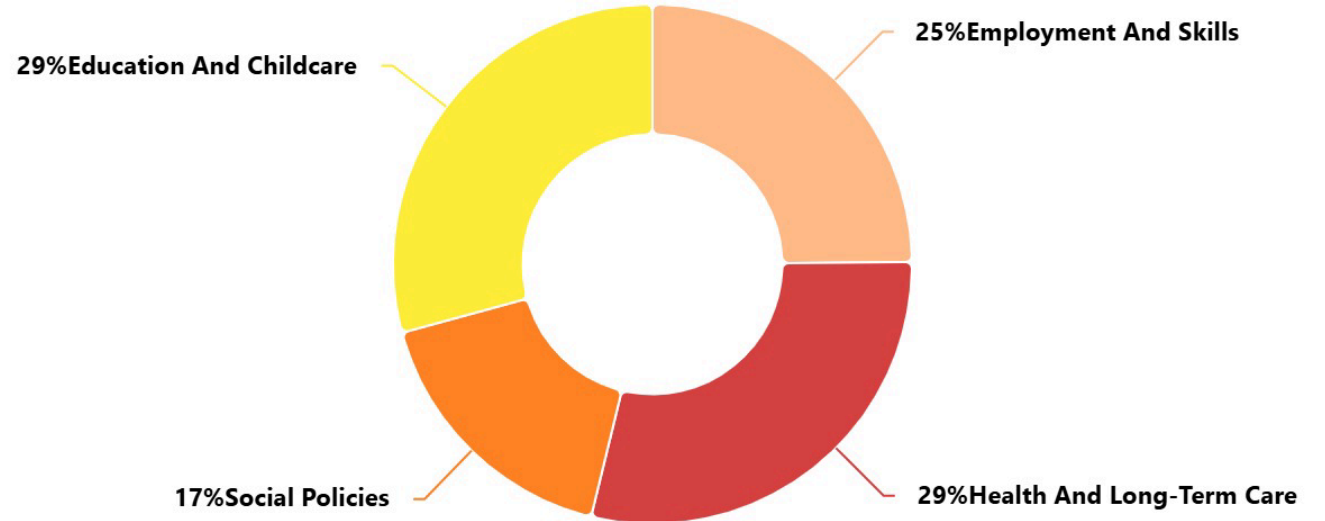


# RRPs foster social convergence with €163\* billion allocated for social objectives

# The RRF is building stronger, resilient and accessible health systems

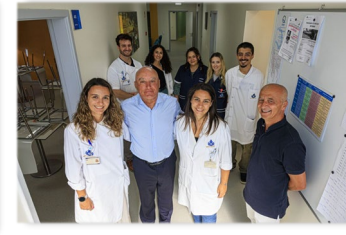
RRF



- **€49 billion** allocated to healthcare and long-term care.

## Expanding access to primary healthcare

**Example:** As part of the implementation of the Sláintecare reform programme, Ireland put in place multi-disciplinary community health networks (CHN).

**Impact:** 96 CHN delivering local primary health services were created.



## Digitalising health services and tools

**Example:** France deployed secure electronic health records on the digital health platform 'Mon Espace Santé'.

**Impact:** More than 40 million citizens now have electronic health records.



## Modernising health infrastructure

**Example:** Croatia upgraded the clinical hospital centre Sestre Milosrdnice with modern equipment, digital tools, and a renovated neurosurgery clinic.

**Impact:** The hospital now serves over 700 000 patients a year.



## Strengthening workforce capacity

**Example:** Sweden provided staff trainings to increase the quality of the country's long-term care system.

**Impact:** So far, 1,500 staff members working in elderly care were trained.



# The RRF is increasing the accessibility and affordability of housing

RRF



- €19.6 billion allocated towards the housing sector.

## Boosting the housing supply through reforms

**Example:** The Housing Pact 2.0 reform in Luxemburg incentivise municipalities to make available land for construction, and to renovate existing dwellings.

**Impact:** between 10% and 30% of each development project is dedicated to affordable housing.



## Renovating social housing

**Example:** Belgium is investing in the renovation of social housing stock to improve its adequacy.

**Impact:** more than 4 700 homes renovated across all Belgian regions.



## More homes through redevelopment and construction

**Example:** Italy increasing the quality or the quantity of public housing and renovating urban degraded areas.

**Impact:** more than 10.000 additional social housing units across the country available.



## Delivering more social and affordable housing units

**Example:** Portuguese RRP includes a Supporting Programme for Access to Housing through the creation of new social housing and the renovation of existing one.

**Impact:** the programme supports 26 000 households.



# The RRF is helping children and young people

## RRF



- Member States are supporting children and youth through **education at all levels, social protection, employment support and housing**.
- More than **€66 billion** are dedicated *directly* to reforms and investments (420 measures) supporting children and youth - **10% of the total RRF envelope**. A significant proportion of the funding is also supporting policies that will *indirectly* benefit children and young people. Tangible results include:

### Early childhood education and care

**Example:** In Cyprus, a reform on gradual extension of free compulsory pre-primary education from the age of four is in force.

**Impact:** greater classroom capacity in public kindergartens and subsidies to make ECEC more affordable.



### Access to higher education

**Example:** Spanish RRP includes a reform of universities to promote access to higher education, research, and mobility of teaching and research staff.

**Impact:** new performance-based funding of public universities and cooperation with the private and third sector.



### Faster entry into the labour market

**Example:** providing 18-months subsidies, Slovenia is supporting open-ended contracts for people under-30.

**Impact:** 700 young people signed open-ended contracts with employers, entering the labour market with quality jobs.



### Preventing and addressing vulnerability in young families

**Example:** Austria rolled out early childhood interventions to support families in vulnerable situations during pregnancy and early childhood.

**Impact:** The programme has achieved full coverage in all districts.
