




## Green transition

**37,6%** of plan allocated to **climate** objectives



- Overhaul of the Riga Metropolitan area transport (€ 295 million)
- Energy efficiency in private and public buildings (€ 248 million)
- Modern and green electricity networks(€ 80 million)
- Climate adaptation measures against fires and floods (€ 70 million)



**DNSH:** No measure in the plan harms environmental objectives

### **Key reform**

Simplification of legal framework to foster onshore wind



## Digital transition

 21% of plan allocated to digital objectives 21%

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### **Key reforms**

Reskilling and upskilling, including basic and advanced digital skills (€ 95 million)

### Sectors specific actions

- Public sector

### **Key investments**

- Upgrading public IT platforms and infrastructure (€ 129 million)
- Digitisation of businesses (€ 125 million)
- 5G deployment (€ 12.5 million)

 Higher education reforms: improving governance, the accreditation mechanism and funding principles (€ 82.5 million)








# Audit and control – Protection of the EU's financial interests

- Double funding




### **Audit and control systems:**

- Sufficient and robust
- Largely based on ESIF arrangements
- Implementation of the plan and A&C segregated
- The Ministry of Finance performs the functions of Managing Authority
- The Audit Authority is an independent and appropriately segregated department of the Ministry of Finance

## Costing

- The plan includes individual cost estimates for all measures
- Cost breakdown is generally detailed and well substantiated
- The costs are to a medium extent well justified, reasonable and plausible.
- Costs are for the most part commensurate, and in line with the principle of cost-efficiency
- A mechanism is in place to ensure no double funding from other EU programmes





## Investing in people

### **Digital upskilling**

- Improve the digital skills of 54500 individuals and 62900 public sector employees,
- Educate 1000 high-level ICT professionals





### Skills for adults

Introduce individual learning accounts and enterprise- and sector -based skills funds
Upskill 20 450 jobseekers

### **General education**

Improve the quality of regional schools by coupling investment with the optimization of school network.

- -Upgrade infrastructure & equipment of 20 schools
- -15 low emission school buses
- -26 620 digital equipment available for schools

### **Higher education**

Improve governance, the accreditation mechanism and funding principles for the higher education sector
